The Rackham Choir High School Vocal Internship Program is designed to support students with exceptional vocal talent and commitment who are entering their sophomore, junior, or senior year of high school in fall 2021 and who plan to study music in college. Rackham Choir high school vocal interns

- Receive a scholarship to partially fund private vocal instruction with an approved instructor
- Enjoy full membership in **Rackham Choir** with dues waived for the 2021-2022 season:
- Receive coaching in vocal literature with Maestro Acton and collaborative pianist Joseph Jackson in preparation for college auditions and master classes
- Perform in a master class with professional artists serving as clinicians
- Be a featured soloist in a spring concert showcasing the RSC High School Vocal Interns

To be considered for an internship, the student must

- Be in good academic standing
- Provide a recommendation by a school choral director, vocal teacher, principal, or counselor.
- Complete and return the enclosed application and letter of recommendation prior to April 27, 2021 along with a **video-taped** recording of yourself singing two contrasting musical selections—any genre of classical music appropriate for young voices is acceptable. Selections must be memorized.

Finalists will be invited to do a live final audition via Zoom on May 6.
